

Dear Greenwood Park Members -

While this email is lengthy, please **read everything below** covering Membership, Entertainment, 4th of July, Swim Team News, Parties, Lifeguard Certification, Swim Lessons and snack bar.

FINALLY, the moment we have all been waiting for! If you haven't heard, pools are **allowed to open in NJ on Monday, June 22nd!!!** We have been working hard to make sure the pool will be ready!

We are also following both the NJ Department of Health Guidance for Operating Pool Bathing Facilities and CDC Guidelines and trying to make things as safe as possible for everyone including but not limited to:

- Contactless member check in process. *Please have your membership key tag with barcode out and ready to present to our front desk staff.* Family members can take a picture of the card and hold their phone under the scanner to check in. NO member will be allowed to enter without being scanned. Please help us protect our front desk staff and members by being prepared.
- All members and guests will need to practice social distancing of six feet in all areas of GPBLCC. Parents are responsible for social distancing their child while in the pools and on the grounds. The deck will be marked off to indicate six feet areas. Families and their friends that are comfortable being closer to each other may move closer.
- All members and guests will need to sign a Covid waiver before entering the club. Click here to print out a copy: [GPBLCC Covid Waiver](#)
- The maximum amount of people in the pool at any given time will not exceed 107. The maximum amount of people in the club is 400.
- Any pool member or guest who are clearly demonstrating signs of Covid-19 will be asked to leave immediately and seek medical attention. The most common symptoms of Covid-19 are listed below, but not limited to:
 - Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Diarrhea
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
- Requiring the use of hand sanitizer upon entry and exiting.
- Taking the temperature of every person who enters our gates. This includes all staff members of GPBLCC before starting their shift, members, guests, vendors, and all entertainment.
- Hourly cleaning and sanitizing of all rest rooms, door handles, life-vests, and heavily touched areas such as railings and benches etc.
- All employees will wash their hands and use hand sanitizer at least twice an hour.

- Pools will continue to be treated with chlorine/bromine - which the virus does not survive in.
- Members can use their own water play equipment, including but not limited to goggles, snorkels, fins, pool toys. Sharing of water play equipment is prohibited except immediate family members, caretakers, and household members.
- Water fountain will be closed this summer.
- As in previous years, there will not be a lifeguard for the baby pool area. An adult (18 years or older) needs to accompany and supervise children in that area.
- Encouraging use of face masks when NOT in the water.
- Masks are NOT allowed in any of the pools. Since we are an outside facility, masks are not required but *RECOMMENDED* especially in line for the snack bar, check in, bathrooms, and anywhere else where other members and guests are present within 6 feet.
- Footwear is required in bathrooms along with a limited amount of people in restroom at same time.
- Per the State of NJ, playgrounds will remain closed. Basketball, volleyball, and cornhole will be available. Staff will sanitize before lending out to the next member.

By no means is this a complete list. The Guidelines continuously change and we are modifying things accordingly to ensure the safety of staff, guests, and members. If the State allows pools to loosen their regulations, we will be following their recommendations.

MEMBERSHIP FOR 2020

To accommodate our members for the inconvenience of the pool being closed, we are opening the pool full-time this year on Thursday, June 11th and we will also be open in September on the weekends. **This will bring the 2020 season from 90 days to 100 days at NO ADDITIONAL COST to membership. Our membership fees for 2020 will remain the same. Additionally, any member that pays in full by June 22nd, will receive an additional five (5) guest passes (valued at \$50/\$10 a piece) for a total of seven (7) guest passes for the 2020 season (\$70 value).** Please see the following breakdown:
